BYLAW No. 1 - 2003

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the R.M. of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Council may appoint a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the municipality, which appointment shall be by resolution of Council.
- 2. The appointment shall be for a term specified by resolution.
- 3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving one month written notice.
- 4. The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
- (a) to ensure proper application and full compliance with Bylaw No. 2-2000, a Bylaw to provide for restricting the weight of vehicles on certain roads in the municipality;
- (b) any other Bylaw or duties as prescribed by Council.
- (c) to represent the municipality before a Justice of the Peace or a Provincial Court Judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with a contravention of a municipal bylaw.
- 5. Remuneration for the Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be established in the resolution appointing the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

6. Bylaw No. 3-2002, is hereby repealed.
