

BYLAW No. 2-2003

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw, the expression:

(a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such act;


(b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.

2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than sixty (60) kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows:

- 1) North of Section 20-44-16-3;
- 2) East of Sections 17 & 20-44-16-3.
- 3) North of Section 24-43-16-3;


3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and at the end of the speed zone area, a maximum speed sign indicating the next succeeding maximum speed shall be erected.

4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.




