

BYLAW No. 2-95

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTINGUISHING
OF FIRES AND FOR LEVYING THE COSTS
PURSUANT TO THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989.

The council of The Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Subject to the availability of fire fighting men and equipment, the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 will provide fire fighting services throughout the municipality.

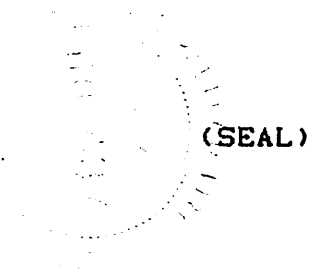
1. The cost of fire fighting service shall be charged directly on the persons who receive this service.

2. The following fee for service will be levied for each and every fire fighting service:

\$ 250.00 per call.

3. The "fee for service," levy shall be in addition to the actual costs incurred for City of North Battleford Fire Department charges, fire fighters fees, vehicle mileage of fire fighters, and payment of water tanker fees.

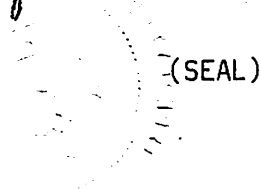
4. Bylaw No. 1-93, enacted August 10, 1993, is hereby repealed.
