BY-LAW No. 29-64

A By-law to compel the removal of dirt, stones, filth, dust or rabbish from off the roads, road allowances, lands acquired for the widening of or diversions from road allowances, lanes or other public places within the municipality.

- The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 enacts as follows:
- 1. No person shall throw, place, deposit or leave on any roads, road allowances, lands acquired for the widening of or diversions from road allowances, lames or other public places in the municipality any dirt, stones, filth, dust or rubbish.
- 2. Any person throwing, placing, depositing or leaving on any public place within the municipality any dirt, stones, filth, dust or rubbish shall, within twenty-four (24) hours after having been notified by the council, the health officer, or any municipal official acting on their behalf, remove said dirt, stones, filth, dust or rubbish and place same where directed by the notice, and in default of so doing the council may order removal at the expense of the person in default, and the municipality may recover the expenses thereof with costs by action in any court of competent jurisdiction or in like manner as municipal taxes.
- 3. The payment of a fine for infraction of this by-law shall not relieve the person in default from liability under Section Two (2).
- 4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this by-law shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty By-law of the Municipality.
- 5. By-law No. 2-54, passed on August 2nd, 1954, is hereby repealed.
