

BYLAW No. 46-74

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY

The council of the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the Municipality.
2. Section Three (3) shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided and which such bylaw states shall incur the penalties herein provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section Two (2), any person found guilty of an infraction of any bylaw of the municipality passed by authority of The Rural Municipality Act shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and costs for every offence and, in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days unless the said penalty and costs, including costs of committal, are sooner paid.
4. All penalties and fines imposed for infraction of a bylaw shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the treasurer for the public use of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 3-54, approved on August 10, 1954, is hereby repealed.
