A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD No. 437, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL OF THE SAID MUNICIPALITY TO ENTER INTO A ROAD AMBULANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT.


1. The Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the councils of:

the terms of which agreement will form a part of this bylaw, for the purpose of establishing a municipal road ambulance association to provide road ambulance service:

(a) throughout the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437

2. The Municipal Road Ambulance Association is hereby directed and empowered to enter into an agreement with (i) a Union Hospital, an individual or a duly incorporated organization to provide road ambulance services; or (ii) to purchase and operate the required equipment for the purpose of providing road ambulance services.
3. The Municipality shall pay an operating grant to the Association and such grant shall be determined each year.
4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
