

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS

The Council of the R.M. of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in The Highways Act, other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
2. Signs containing the word "stop" shall be erected at the following locations:
  - i) On the SE 16-44-16-3 on the west side of the road facing traffic from the northerly direction.
3. Yield signs shall be erected at the following locations:
  - i) On the SE 18-44-15-3 on the west side of the road facing traffic from the northerly direction.
  - ii) On the SE 26-45-14-3 on the west side of the road facing traffic from the northerly direction.
  - iii) On the NE 7-44-14-3 on the west side of the grid commonly called the Denholm Grid, facing traffic from the westerly direction.
  - iv) On the SE 6-44-14-3 on the west side of the Denholm Grid facing traffic from the northerly direction.
  - v) On the NW 32-43-14-3 on the east side of the Denholm Grid facing traffic from the southerly direction.
  - vi) On the SW 5-43-14-3 on the east side of the Denholm Grid facing traffic from the easterly direction.
  - vii) On the SW 29-44-14-3 on the east side of the Denholm Grid facing traffic from the easterly direction.
  - viii) On the SE 17-44-15-3 on the west side of the road facing traffic from the northerly direction.
  - ix) On the NW 9-44-15-3 on the east side of the road facing traffic from the southerly direction.
4. All signs erected pursuant to section 2 and 3 shall be erected not less than three metres and not more than fifteen metres from the near edge of the intersected roadway.
5. The provisions of The Vehicles Act shall apply, wherever applicable, to every sign erected pursuant to section 2 and 3.
6. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this bylaw.
7. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
8. Bylaw No. 65-81, approved March 27, 1981, is hereby repealed.
