

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD NO. 437

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PRIMARY WEIGHTS ON DESIGNATED ROADS

BYLAW NO. 5-2020

The Council of The R.M. of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purposes of this bylaw are to:

- a. Designate a primary weight haul route, and
- b. Establish the maximum weights allowed

2. Definitions

Words in this bylaw shall have the meaning ascribed to them in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.

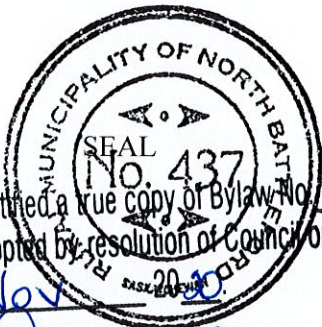
3. Designated Primary Weight Haul Routes

The following roads located within the jurisdiction of the municipality shall be designated as primary weight routes:

- South side of the SE of 18-45-16-W3 from Highway 4 westerly to the SE corner of the SW of 18-45-16-W3;
- South side of Section 30-44-16-W3, from Highway 4 westerly to the SE corner of the SE of 26-44-17-W3;
- From Highway 16 South and easterly to the Viterra Terminal;
- East of the NW of 31-43-15-W3 and West of the NE of 36-43-15-W3 on the municipal roadway connecting to Highway 40;
- South of the SE of 30-45-16-W3 and North of the NE of 19-45-16-W3
- From Highway 4 North westerly along the South side of Section 30-44-17-W3

4. Maximum Weights

The maximum gross vehicle weights allowed to be moved on or over the designated primary weight haul routes as described in Section 3 of this bylaw shall be the maximum primary weights as set out in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.
