BYLAW NO. 6-2006

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH BATTLEFORD No. 437 TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of The Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw, the expression:
- (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Traffic Safety Act, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such act;
- (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Traffic Safety Act.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than fifty (50) kilometers per hour on that portion of the public highway described as:
- i) Island View Drive as named in Plan No. 78-B-00791, from its intersection with the SE 15-45-17-3, westerly, to the most northern point of Lot 1, Blk. 1, Plan 78-B-00791.
- 3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and at the end of the speed zone area, a maximum speed sign indicating the next succeeding maximum speed shall be erected.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
