

Invoices shall be sent within 30 days from the date of the fire.
- c) All parties agree that:
  In the case of simultaneous events, each will be responsible for the event within their own corporate boundaries.
  Each will be responsible for their own insurance coverage.

  - Each will be responsible for their own equipment.
