Memorandum of Agreement made this <u>al</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2019

The R.M. of North Battleford No. 437 and the R.M. of Mayfield No. 406

- 1. Now therefore this agreement witnessed that in consideration of the covenants, terms and conditions hereinafter set out the aforementioned parties hereby agree to the following:
- a) The R.M. of Mayfield No. 406 agrees to provide fire protection and emergency services, as hereinafter set out, to the R.M. of North Battleford No. 437.
- b) The R.M. of North Battleford No. 437 agrees to provide fire protection and emergency services, as hereinafter set out, to the R.M. of Mayfield No. 406.
- c) The municipalities in this agreement guarantee that the departments providing fire protection and emergency services within the corporate boundaries of the other municipality agrees to pay for that service when provided.
- d) Both parties agree that:
 - Each will set their own fees to be charged for providing fire protection and emergency services
 - In the case of simultaneous fires, each will be responsible for the fire within their own corporate boundaries
 - Each will be responsible for their own insurance coverage
 - Each will be responsible for their own equipment even when providing fire protection and emergency services in the municipality.
 - Each agrees to invoice their own individual ratepayers for services received from the other fire department.
- 2. It is understood that this agreement shall commence on August 21, 2019 and will be continuous; either party may terminate the contract with seven days written
