


# Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437

## BYLAW No. 5-2023


### A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE FURNISHING OF FIRE FIGHTING SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 is hereby authorized to enter into agreements that are attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw identified as EXHIBIT A with the:
  - Town of Hafford and
  - RM of Redberry No. 435
2. The Reeve, Fire Chief and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of North Battleford No. 437 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as EXHIBIT A.



EXHIBIT A

Fire Protection and Emergency Services Agreement

This Agreement made the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2023.

BETWEEN: R.M. of North Battleford No. 437

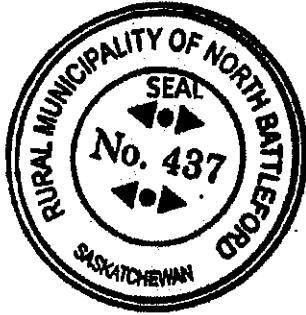
AND: Town of Hafford


AND: RM of Redberry No. 435


1. Now therefore this agreement witnessed that in consideration of the covenants, terms and conditions hereinafter set out the aforementioned parties hereby agree to the following:
  - a) To provide fire protection and emergency services to each other on request.
  - b) The municipalities in this agreement guarantee that the departments providing fire protection and emergency services within the corporate boundaries of the other municipality agrees to pay for that service when provided.
  - c) Both parties agree that:
    - Each will set their own fees to be charged for providing fire protection and emergency services
    - In the case of simultaneous fires, each will be responsible for the fire within their own corporate boundaries
    - Each will be responsible for their own insurance coverage
    - Each will be responsible for their own equipment even when providing fire protection and emergency services in the municipality.
    - Each agrees to invoice their own individual ratepayers for services received from the other fire department.
2. It is understood that this agreement shall commence at the above date and will be continuous; either party may terminate the contract with seven days written notice.




