- Students must provide confirmation of their enrollment in eligible courses;

- Students must submit a completed application form, which includes an essaythat outlines why they are or would like to work in municipal government;
- Students may apply multiple times and are eligible to a maximum of \$2000.

- 2. A certified statement of your most recent academic marks.
- 3. Attach an essay, no greater than 1000 words, indicating why you wish to be involved in Municipal Government.
